

## April 1, 2016 Rate Changes related to the USDOL Home Care Rule

Section 29 of the Legislative Conference Report on Appropriations authorizes rate increases for iBudget waiver services that must be in compliance with the US Department of Labor Home Care Rule. This section specifies that the revised rates are effective April 1, 2016. The rates addressed are:

- Personal Supports 1:1 Daily and Quarter Hour;
- Life Skills Development Level 1 - Companion 1:1;
- Respite 1:1 Daily and Quarter Hour; and
- Residential Habilitation Live-In 1:1

APD will adjust service authorizations for impacted services effective April 1, 2016. Service providers can expect revised service authorizations just before April 1, 2016. The proposed rate amounts are as follows:

## July 1, 2016 Rate Changes

Specific Appropriation 259 of the Legislative Conference Report on Appropriations authorizes the following rate increases effective July 1, 2016:

- Personal Supports;
- Residential Habilitation;
- Adult Day Training; and
- Adult Day Training 1:3 only

APD will make the adjustment to service authorizations for these services effective July 1, 2016. Service providers can expect that revised service authorizations with the new rates just before July 1, 2016.
